

Kindergarten Enrolment 2018

Do you have a child who is turning 5 before July 31 in 2018? If so, NOW is the time to enrol your child at our wonderful school. Alternatively if you have neighbours and friends within our local area, please encourage them to enrol now. As we now provide every student in our school with their own designated XO (laptop) computer for the year, it is vital we know how many new students we will be getting so that we can have these ready to go at the start of 2018 for all new students. Preschool Enrolment 2017

Our Preschool classes for 2018 are almost full. As you are aware, we cannot exceed 20 children per class (we have two preschool classes) so if you are wanting your child to attend our preschool, please contact the office and enrol your child before the end of this term.

Thank you to the families who have returned notes for camp. I had the pleasure of announcing last week that due to a generous subsidisation from the P&C, the cost of the camp would be \$55 cheaper, bringing it down to only \$300 for each student for the week long camp. All students attending have been provided with a note explaining how medical and dietary details are collected by the venue. This year, Milson Island require you to do it online. If you have lost the note, please let the office know and they can provide you with the information. If for some reason you are unable to access the internet from home, there is a computer at the office you may use to do this – please come and see our office staff and they will assist you.



