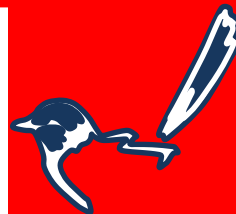

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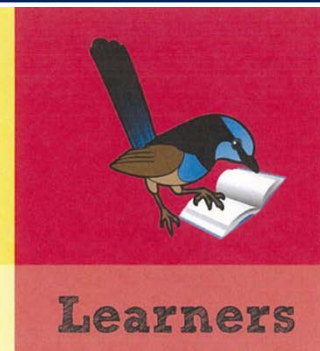

It will be a Gymnastics and Dance program run by the same company who did our fundamental movements program during Semester 1 (SISA). Every minute of your child's schooling counts!! To ensure learning is not lost, please make sure your child arrives at school prior to 9am. The table below shows you how much your child's learning is hindered by missing just minutes of learning each day:

Check the time school starts. DON'T BE LATE!



All students who arrive late MUST be accompanied to the office by an adult to be signed in. The adult must also provide the office staff with a reason for the absence so this can be recorded. Any absence (either partial of full day) must be justified with a reason. This is a legal requirement. Don't forget that you can submit absence notes for who day absences via our app.




