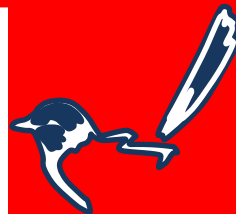

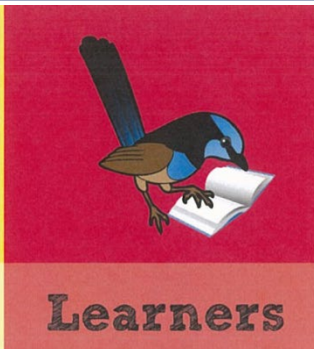

Late Arrivals

Every minute of your child's schooling counts!! To ensure learning is not lost, please make sure your child arrives at school prior to 9am. The table below shows you how much your child's learning is hindered by missing just minutes of learning each day:

EVERY MINUTE COUNTS....

When your child misses just...	that equals...	which is...	so from Kindy to Year 12, they will miss out on
10 minutes a day	50 minutes of learning each week	Nearly 1½ weeks per year	6 months
20 minutes a day	1 hour and 40 minutes of learning each week	Nearly 2½ weeks per year	Nearly a year
¼ hour a day	¼ a day of learning a week	4 weeks a year	Nearly 1 ½ years
1 hour each day	1 whole day of learning each week	8 weeks per year or nearly a term a year.	Over 2 ½ years

Your child's best learning time is at the beginning of the day...

Check the time school starts. DON'T BE LATE!



All students who arrive late **MUST** be accompanied to the office by an adult to be signed in. The adult must also provide the office staff with a reason for the absence so this can be recorded. Any absence (either partial or full day) must be justified with a reason. This is a legal requirement. Don't forget that you can submit absence notes for whole day absences via our app.
