YELLOW GROUP

This fortnight you will be sorting the vc and vcc words that end with -ing. You will be working on identifying if the word changes when adding ing or stays the same.

BLUE GROUP

This fortnight you are sorting your word sorts into groups that have the 'i' sound and groups that have the 'u' sound. E.g. dig is in the 'i' group and bug is in the 'u' group.

GREEN GROUP

This fortnight you will be sorting unaccented final syllables (words that end with en, on, ain, in and make the 'n' sound). You will be sorting words the sound the same but are spelt in different ways. You will need to sort words according to their end sound. PINK GROUP

This fortnight you will be sorting unaccented final syllables (le, el, il, al). You will be sorting words which end with the l sound but have different spelling. Here is a clip to explain it before you start sorting! <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=N6JebC8x2c0>

PURPLE GROUP

This fortnight you will be sorting long vowel and short vowel sounds. You will be sorting words which have the short o and long o sound. You will identify the bossy e and double vowels in the middle of a word that make the short and long o sound. These will help you identify spelling patterns within words. By looking at the picture and titles- discuss with a partner what is happening?


Where might the family be going? What may make you think that the journey is an extended one?

What do you think the book might be about? Does the boat look safe?


Have you ever been on a boat? What was it like? Did you enjoy it? Discuss different boating experiences.
